4. At the Women's Therapy Center, we are very interested in understanding people in their social and cultural context. Please tell us a bit about your own experience with difference or oppression and how this informs your approach to psychotherapy.
5. What are your goals in seeking training at the Women's Therapy Center?

**Submitting your application.** Applications for the first round of interviews (which will be held in Late March) are due Friday Feb. 29, 2008. Applications received after this date will be granted interviews on a space-permitting basis. Please deliver or mail to the address listed at the top of the first page, marked "Intern Application." If you deliver this application personally, please drop in mail slot beside the front door (Kearney Street Entrance) of 501 Kearney Street.

**Important Information.** The first round of interviews will be held on the weekend of March 28th – 30th, 2008. We will contact you after the application deadline to arrange an interview time. If you know now of any scheduling difficulties, please include that in a letter with this application. After interviews and upon your acceptance into the program, a non-refundable \$100.00 Acceptance Fee will be due. If this presents an extreme financial hardship for you, flexible payment plans may be arranged.
